Eckinger Law opens office in Orrville

ORRVILLE — Eckinger Law Offices has opened a new expanded second office in Orrville on state Route 57. The law office is located in the Hummel Insurance/CS Bank building on Route 57 just north of the Smucker's Store and Café.

Eckinger Law Offices maintains a primary office in North Canton. The law practice was formed in 1995 when Bob Eckinger opened the first office in Canton, with a small satellite office in Dalton. Bob Eckinger, who previously worked as a chemical engineer in the rubber and plastics industry, attended

and attended Dalton Local Schools.
